1 x	Box chalk white and & 1 x Box coloured chalk
1 x	Packet of stars and a packet of dots
1 x	A suitcase large enough to accommodate lunch, shoes and jersey (must be able to stand upright)
1 x	12 Retractable wax crayons (no fluorescent colours, in original packaging)
1 x	Pair of scissors (small round nose) IF your child is left-handed, a left-handed scissor please!
1 x	Puzzle, minimum of 48 (no more than 80) pieces (one with lots of colour and detail) NO SUPER HEROES
1 x	Skipping rope, plain ROPE type (ensure the length is appropriate for your child)
1 x	Hoop (label clearly)
1 x	Large ball + 1 tennis ball
1 x	Beanbag
1 x	Packet of 12 colour pencils (Material Pencil Bag)
1 x	3 x empty 2 L ice-cream tubs or 8 L Rectangle Multi storage box Child's name on each box
1 x	Box of plasters
1 x	Wet wipes
1 x	A non-permanent white board marker & white board + black board + (30cm x 30cm) duster
2 x	2HB-pencils
20	Laminating pages
1 x	Colouring-in book (large pictures, no super-heroes)
1 x	Paint brush no 12 + 1 Activity apron (plastic)
4 x	Plastic envelopes + Unifix blocks min 20
1 x	Pallet of paint 12 colours

Play Dough (Recipe) (or teddy dough)

250ml flour, 100ml salt, 15ml crème of tartar, 225ml water, 15ml oil & Food colouring
